

We've built tools and services for open source software, including VSCode and TSLint, and we love that GitHub is the default home for open source. When we sit down to build a new service, we never want to leave GitHub. Today, however, GitHub made a choice that we cannot and will not support. GitHub is actively removing our users' ability to issue, view, and resolve Pull Requests. They tell us this is for security, and that we can comply by handing over our users' source code for analysis and monitoring. We will not comply. We don't want to hand over the source code of our users to third parties. GitHub has put itself in a position where it can decide which projects are open source and which projects are proprietary software. We're not going to make that choice for our users. We're also not going to give up our source code and tools. We will maintain our GitHub repositories and move our user base to alternative services. We cannot support GitHub going forward. We want to focus on our users, not on how to comply with their demands. We hope you will join us in this decision. We are going to use our influence and user base to help companies understand the importance of open source software and to encourage GitHub to reconsider this decision. Q: CSS: Floating elements not vertically aligned when dynamically adding content I have a list of input fields that I'm trying to dynamically add content to.
